Note: Core switches should be installed in a central location that meets cable distance requirements for the media used between core and access switches. Before installing switches, download the Aruba Installation Guide for the specific models. It connects all servers within the rack using short copper or optical cables and aggregates their traffic before sending it upstream to aggregation or core switches.
