

# Cable rack partition position



## Overview

Position drawers in racks to allow enough space, where possible, for cable routing on the bottom and top of the rack, and between drawers. Shorter drawers should not be placed between longer drawers in the rack (for example, placing a 19-inch drawer between two). In high-density environments, planning the server rack layout in advance is crucial. Identify all components, map out their positions, and avoid unnecessary relocation after installation. You should avoid simply bundling excess cable as this can often lead to EMI or even damage to the cable due to excess bends. There are.
