

Can BV wires be run inside cable trays



Overview

The regulations dictate that the cables must either be Type TC (also known as Tray Rated) or must be metal-armored (Type MC). A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require additional protection to support and protect numerous small. In all instances cables utilized within a cable tray system should be UL listed and marked as cable tray rated.
