The aqua color (hex: #00B6C1) is instantly recognizable and signals support for 10, 40, or 100 Gb/s over short distances — up to 300 meters at 10G. OM4 also uses aqua jackets but is sometimes found in Erika Violet (a bright violet color) depending on the manufacturer.
