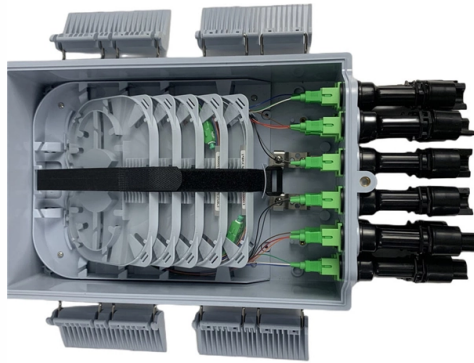


# Dimensions of the cabinet in the low-voltage electrical room
