

EMS Upgrade Version for Communication Sites



Overview

EMS only supports FortiClient 7. With the endpoint security improvement feature, there are backward compatibility issues to consider while planning upgrades. When a later patch of the current EMS version is available, by default, EMS schedules an upgrade at a date between 45 to 52 days in the future. Upgrades to the latest version are distributed over a week to ensure that Fortinet can minimize the impact of any issues and resolve them without affecting the system from earlier versions. You can only migrate EMS of specific 7. Take a backup of the DB and a snapshot of the VM (if virtual) beforehand to be safe, but in my experience I haven't had any.
