The recommended procedures in this data sheet are intended to eliminate the unsafe. Note: The National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70, in Article 400, Table 400-4, lists various types of flexible cords, some of which are noted as being designed for hard or extra-hard usage. Examples of these types of flexible cords include hard service cord (types S, ST, SO, STO) and junior hard. Connection method: Each switch takes a wire from the incoming point and connects it to the incoming end of the switch, or uses parallel connection to reduce the difficulty of wiring.
