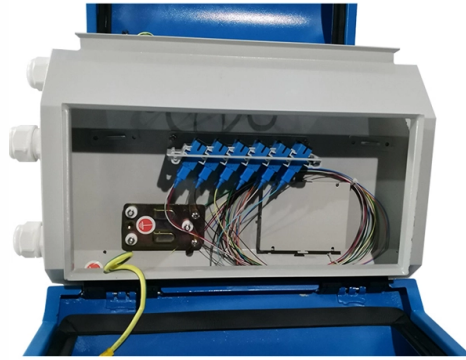


Kenya High-Speed Bridge



Overview

The Rironi-Mau Summit Road project, one of Kenya's most ambitious constructions, was launched by President William Ruto on November 28, 2025. The billion-dollar highway is expected to transform a long-congested and accident-prone route linking Nairobi to Western Kenya and the East. Kenya has officially engaged Chinese state-owned enterprises to execute a landmark \$1.5 billion expansion of the Rironi-Mau Summit highway, marking a significant geopolitical pivot after the cancellation of a prior agreement with a French consortium. President William Ruto personally officiated the. Kenya has set the wheels in motion for one of its most ambitious transport upgrades in recent years as work begins on the Nairobi-Nakuru-Mau Summit highway expansion.
