The maximum range is obtained by dividing the available budget by the attenuation per kilometer of cable: $\text{Maximum distance (km)} = \frac{\text{Available budget (dB)}}{\text{Cable attenuation (dB/km)} - [\text{Fixed losses} / \text{Cable attenuation}]}$ For an OS2 cable with an attenuation of 0,35 dB/km at 1310 nm, 4 connectors (4 x). In a standard ODN (Optical Distribution Network), the fiber route is usually divided into: The drop cable is responsible for the “last mile” connection between the network and the ONT inside the building. While modern single-mode cables achieve under 0. 5 dB per kilometer at 1550nm, light absorption and scattering still accumulate over long spans.
