This problem is more common in older electrical boxes due to wear and tear, but it can also occur in newly installed boxes if there is an issue with the installation. However, in actual applications, distribution boxes often encounter a series of problems, which not. A non-contact voltage tester (NCVT) is the safest method, as it detects the electromagnetic field of live current without requiring physical contact. Test the NCVT first on a known live outlet to ensure its function is reliable before testing the outlet you plan to work on. Using a light switch as a simple example, check each of the three wires.
