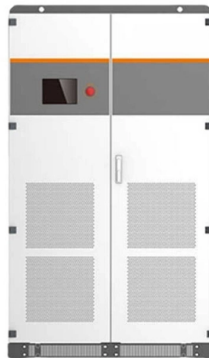


Spacing between cable trays in underground trenches



Overview

When more than one cable is to be laid in the same trench, a horizontal or vertical inter-axial spacing of at least 30 cm is provided in order to reduce the effect of mutual heating and also to ensure that a fault occurring on one cable does not damage the adjacent cable. The purpose of this document is to detail Northern Powergrid (the 'Company') requirements for; cable locations in trench layouts, that apply to Company staff, their contractors and others (the 'Installer') installing network infrastructure to be adopted by the Company at all voltage levels (LV up). Space between cables must be equal to one cable diameter -- $11 \times 1.07 \text{ inches} = 11.77 \text{ inches}$. Total cable tray width required is $12.84 \text{ inches} + 11.77 \text{ inches} = 24.61 \text{ inches}$.
