Overview

QDD-800G-2xDR4 is a high-speed optical module based on PAM4 modulation technology. It complies with QSFP-DD MSA and IEEE 802.3cu standards, supports a total transmission rate of 800Gbps, and integrates 2 independent 400G DR4 channels.
