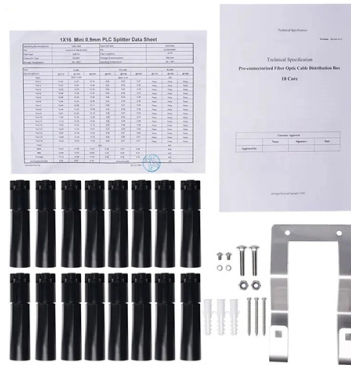


Switch detects illegal access



Overview

Switch and Switch 2 users who try to hack their consoles or play pirated copies of games may find their devices rendered completely inoperable by Nintendo. That new warning was buried in a recent update to the Nintendo User Account Agreement, as first noticed by Game File last. In response, Nintendo has implemented a robust detection system to identify and ban hacked Switch consoles from their online services. Nintendo's May. The FBI, with Dutch authorities, has shut down Nsw2u, a major Nintendo Switch piracy site. This action, part of a broader law enforcement effort, targets platforms providing free, illegal game downloads. Nintendo detects and restricts access even when using backup copies of legitimate games. It took hackers over a year to jailbreak the original Switch, but the Switch 2 has one vulnerability its predecessor didn't: backwards compatibility. Some new console owners have already tried to use a type of flash cartridge associated with the piracy of Switch 1 games on their Switch 2 consoles. The original Nintendo Switch had such a massive piracy problem, hackers were able to play new first-party games weeks before they were available to the public.
