Unlike high-fiber-count backbone cables, FTTH drop cables are characterized by low fiber counts (typically 1 to 4 fibers), smaller diameters, flexibility, and lightweight designs that facilitate easy routing into and within buildings. The drop cable is the "face" of your network to the end-user. The main types of drop cable include indoor drop cable (GJXFH, GJXH, GJXKH), outdoor self-supporting drop cable (GJYXCH, GJYXFCH, GJYXKCH), flat drop cable, and circular drop cable. These cables bridge the gap between an ISP's backbone infrastructure and end-user premises, enabling high-speed internet, voice, and data service in residential. Fiber Optic Drop cable is mostly the single-core, double-core structure, but can also be made into a four-core structure, flat figure-8 structure, reinforcement is located in the center of the two circles, metal or non-metallic structure can be used, the fiber is located in the geometric center of. Optical fiber drop cable, often referred to as FTTH (Fiber to the Home) cable, is the last segment in the fiber optic network, which connects the user's home/building terminal to the backbone cable terminal of an ISP provider. It lies at the end-user side and is necessary when FTTH (Fiber to the Home) is implemented.
