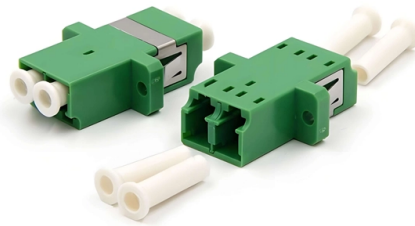

L1 is the first level of power distribution, and it is generally the most basic form. This level typically involves a direct connection between a power source and a device or system, such as an outlet or appliance. It safely divides a main power supply into smaller, protected circuits that feed everything from production machinery to building services. Distribution substations connect to the transmission system and lower the transmission voltage to medium voltage ranging between 2 kV and 33 kV. Primary distribution systems consist of feeders that deliver power from distribution substations to distribution transformers.
